The age range is from 11 years to 19 years of age, and our students are grouped in classes that meet their specific needs.

We are looking to appoint a teacher with energy, flair and enthusiasm who is self-motivated, hardworking and willing to play an important role in helping to maintain and develop an ethos and learning environment within which we recognise and celebrate the contribution of every individual, ensuring that the needs of all of our students are met as effectively as possible.

All applicants are expected to meet Teachers' Standards outstandingly well. You will have good interpersonal, communication and literacy skills, and demonstrate the ability to lead or contribute to the development of particular curriculum areas. The successful candidate will have responsibility as a form tutor.
